

## **Advanced Periodic (Annual) Vehicle Inspection Seminar**

### **Target Audience:**

Maintenance Technicians, Mechanics, Motor Carriers, Passenger Carriers, Driver Trainers  
Safety Personnel, Compliance Personnel, Administration Support, and Owner Operators.

Companies utilizing pickups with trailers, one ton pickups, straight trucks single and tandem axle, all the way up to semi tractors and trailers, or passenger carrying vehicles in the furtherance of their business to transport either property or passengers are required annually complete a Periodic Inspection on all vehicles and trailers in the combination to ensure they are mechanically in full compliance with 49 CFR 393, 396, and Appendix G of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.

Every Inspector is required to be properly qualified and trained by the motor carrier (company) and their qualifications must be maintained on file at the company's office. Additionally, all outside/3rd party inspector qualifications must be confirmed and verified prior to using any 3rd party inspector.

Enforcement officials may require inspectors to demonstrate certain inspection procedures during an official DOT audit in order to verify their qualification. Any inspector who fails to demonstrate proficiency in inspection tasks may be disqualified and all current periodic inspections on file revoked.

### **Description:**

This seminar covers the elements of the DOT Annual Vehicle Inspection by completing a live inspection with the students. During this inspection students will observe a complete North American Standard Inspection and will observe the parts and accessories necessary to inspect for completion of the Periodic Inspection.

Students will learn the steps and procedures necessary to complete the inspection and identify defective components.

Learn the regulatory requirements of an Annual Vehicle Inspection and Appendix G. Inspectors/Technicians will learn what's required for to become qualified inspector and maintain their qualification

### **Objective:**

Maintenance Technicians will receive instruction and demonstration on the North American Standard Inspection Criteria. In the event of a compliance investigation/audit every person performing must be properly qualified must be able to produce a written record of qualification and be able to answer specific questions and demonstrate certain inspection tasks for an enforcement official.
