**Re:** TSA Hazmat Security Clearance Extension

Due to the continued challenges with the COVID-19 pandemic, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) and the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) have approved an additional 180 day extension for the TSA Hazmat Clearance on the conditions that those individuals have been previously approved by TSA and the expiration of their TSA Hazmat Clearance falls between March 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020. This extension is does not impact the expiration of the driver license, only the TSA Hazmat Security Clearance associated with the driving records. Colorado has 2,593 drivers with a TSA Security Clearance expiring between October 31, 2020 and December 31, 2020. Colorado is honoring the extension of the TSA Security Clearance and will be sending a notice to impacted drivers. The expiration date of the driver license itself will not be changed, only the date of the TSA Hazmat Security Clearance.
